## walking routes map

Above is a map with the location of buildings participating in Cork's Heritage Open Day event on August 30th. The map shows the walking routes, which are colour coded along with numbers corresponding to each building in the guide. Plaques featured on page 43 are marked with an orange circle. While most buildings are in the city, a selection from local county areas such as Ballincollig and Crosshaven are also open for visiting, the most direct route to these are indicated by a colour coded arrow at the edge of the map.
